

This Privacy Policy has been posted to inform you of the types, collection methods, purpose of usage and sharing, and security technology related to the information (hereinafter “Personal Information” and “Automatically Provided Information” as defined below) that you provide to gbrick Co., Ltd. (hereinafter “the Company”) when accessing the website operated by gbrick (hereinafter “Website”) or using the services provided through the Website (hereinafter “Services”). We advise you to carefully read the following terms and conditions as this policy stipulates the scope of the Company’s roles and responsibilities in operating the privacy policy, and it applies to your use of the Website and its Services. In addition, all information about the purchase of a token is available through the white paper registered on the website.

## **General Information**

The Company's privacy policy shall be enforced by generally applying the following terms and conditions.

### **1. Age standards**

Only Adults may access the Website or use its Services. The Company considers that a person aged 19 or older is an adult (the statutes of the IP jurisdiction to which you are currently connected may take precedence over the Company’s privacy policy). In case non-adult persons are found to have used the Website or its Services, appropriate measures shall be taken such as user restrictions and information deletion.

### **2. Change in Policy**

The Company may change the Privacy Policy at its discretion. The changed policy shall be posted to the Website upon change, and you are required to check for changes by visiting the Website regularly. If you continue to use the Website and its Services after the change of policy, you shall be deemed to have agreed to the changes and the changed policy shall take effect from that point on. You shall not be able to use the Website unless you agree to its policy. The Company may change the Privacy Policy at its discretion. ## **Types of Information**

There are two types of information that you provide when using the Website and Services: The first is personal information that you directly provide for the use of the Site, and the second is information that is automatically provided to the Company when you use the Site.

### **1. Personal Information**

The personal information requested by the Company is the information required in the KYC procedure such as e-mail addresses. The e-mail address is required for receipt purposes of emails such as, but not limited to, information and Services provided by the Company. KYC is all of the information you submitted yourself for each item requested and specified by the Company to identify restricted subjects such as, but not limited to, citizens, natural individuals, and corporations in a country or region where digital token transactions are restricted or limited by law or regulation.

### **2. Automatically Provided Information**

Your IP address, the duration of visit on a specific page and time of access, the server log information, and your device information are automatically provided via cookies. If you do not want your cookies to be collected, you can block cookie collection by changing your browser's functional settings. In this case, however, inconveniences may be caused while using some functions of the Website and Services.

### **3. Provided Information Management**

The information provided to the Company, such as personal information and automatically provided information, shall not be used for commercial or marketing purposes unless the customer agrees to such use. The information provided shall be managed by the Company in accordance with the Privacy Policy and not used, disclosed, or leaked to any third party without permission.

## **Information Usage**

The Company shall use the information only for the following purposes:

- Send information about the Website, Services and other notices from the Company.
- Provide real-time responses to your requirements and inquiries
- Send regular information on Company-related news to subscribers
- Gather feedbacks to improve the quality of the Website and Services

- Use your cookie information to improve the quality of the Website and Services
- Judge your legality according to your KYC procedures

The Company does not use your personal information except for the above purposes, and the above purposes may be changed according to the circumstances of the Company.

## **Information Retention and Disposal**

The Company shall retain your information until it decides not to use your information anymore or is asked not to hold your information any longer.

The Company shall destroy such information without delay when personal information becomes unnecessary, such as when the information retention period ends or the processing purpose is fulfilled.

## **Information Sharing**

The Company shall only share your information in the following cases:

- If you agreed or instructed the Company to do so.
- Information shall be shared with parent companies, affiliated companies, partner companies, or companies that are jointly controlled or jointly owned by an international office, all of which are currently under contract with the Company.
- If the information needs to be disclosed or is deemed necessary in accordance with the laws, regulations and legal procedures.
- If you have violated the policy, been reported or suspected to have done so.

Your information shall only be shared in the above cases and shall not be shared in any other situation.

## **Security Technology**

The Company implements safety measures and methods to protect your personal information while using the Website and providing Services and information. Your personal information becomes encrypted or unidentified to be stored in the Company's database, and the industry's standard practices such as firewalls and SSL are enforced, too. Since the Company cannot guarantee complete safety, however, you should also use the services with caution and stay alert.

## **External Site Links**

You may be linked to a third party external website through links available at the Website and Services. If you enter a third party site that is not directly operated by the Company, you shall be subject to the policies such site (refers to all policies, including privacy policy) and no longer that of the Company. The Company does not have the authority to control and manage the privacy policy of the third-party website and shall not be held accountable for any damage or loss whatsoever caused by the information obtained through the third-party website.

## **KYC**

The Company reserves the right to conduct “Know your customer” and/or “Anti-money laundering” checks and procedures on the Purchasers if required by the applicable laws. The Purchaser undertakes to provide all the information requested by the Company in respect to conducting KYC or AML checks/procedures. In the event that the Purchaser fails or refuses to provide the specific and necessary information requested by the Company in due time, it shall be in the Company’s power to terminate the Purchaser’s rights to use the Website, as well as stop providing services to such Purchaser without any obligation on the Company part to refund or indemnify the Purchaser.
